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The Council of the Royal Art Society is charged with the responsibility of maintaining the high standard of art required by its exhibiting members. Works submitted by exhibiting member applicants will be carefully and thoughtfully considered by a panel of competent and professional artists with many years of painting experience.

Each artist's work is assessed using the firm principals of structure, colour sense, drawing ability, originality and creativity.

These principles apply to all types of painting and include abstract, contemporary or traditional.

It is better to show us consistency in your work rather than present a variety of subject matter that perhaps needs more time to develop. If you specialize in portraits, still-life, landscapes, abstract or any other form of art, present the style that you do best. Works done in workshops are not permitted.

### \*\* A drawing must be included in all applications.

All works submitted must be appropriately framed. Framing is important in the presentation of our exhibitions and the way that you frame your submitted artwork will give the council an idea of how you will present work for acceptance into our regular exhibitions.

Works for the Society's regular exhibitions are selected by a majority vote by the Council by similar criteria as the exhibiting member applications.

Each painting is scrutinized carefully and consideration is given to the way the painting is presented; poorly matched or damaged frames are not acceptable as they bring down the standard of the whole.

Society exhibitions held throughout the year are open to all exhibiting members. Members can also apply for a private members' exhibition when space is available.

Successful applicants will pay a joining fee of \$50 plus yearly fee of \$120.

The Society consists of Social, Exhibiting, Associates and Fellows. The Fellows meet twice per year to consider, after viewing the exhibitions; for the purpose of nominating for elevation those artists they feel have reached a certain level of artistic achievement.

Once accepted as an Exhibiting Member there is a two year period before a nomination or elevation to Associate can take place. The same two year period applies before an Associate can be nominated for Fellow status.
