RAS Artists in the Landscape

En Plein Air

We are featuring artists of the RAS painting en plein air.

In in Tuscany, the Macchiaioli group of Italian painters were breaking the antiquated traditions of the academies in the second half of the 19th century. Beginning in the 1850's, these artists did much of their painting outdoors, where they could capture the colour, shade and natural light of the environment accurately. The practice of painting *en plein air* connects this group of artists with the French Impressionists, who became prominent several years later.

Next in the series is of Associate, Deb Morgan and her artist statement is:

"I love to be outdoors painting, it's then I can feel the atmosphere, temperature along with the spells and sounds that will inspire me to paint.

The way a shadow becomes full of shapes and tones intrigues me along with the way the light dances on a subject".



Art Renewal Centre Living Master and Faculty Artist for the Portrait Society of America, Tina Garrett shares with students the practical methods she uses in her award-winning portraiture. Student will learn how to see and simplify values, create form, and understand edges and chroma to control composition and create dramatic portraits. In the mornings Tina will demonstrate her oil painting techniques and, in the afternoons, she will work one-on-one with every participant to help them create their own artworks. All levels welcome.
